



## GRANT FOR MUSIC PROGRAM APPLICATION

### PURPOSE

The core purpose of the CALI\*ROCK grant program is to provide funding for high-school music programs for the purchase of instruments and equipment for student use. CALI\*ROCK exists to help preserve music education in California High Schools.

### ELIGIBILITY

Any school or individual may apply for funding. High schools with established music programs must apply by and through their music teacher and/or program director. High schools without a music teacher or director may apply through the principal's designee.

### REVIEW PROCESS

Applications will be reviewed and grants awarded on a case-by-case basis. Preference will be given to schools with the greatest need as determined by CALI\*ROCK.

### SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Applicants must include with this application an essay explaining why their school needs music-program funding along with the following information:
